Sydney - Tower Eye

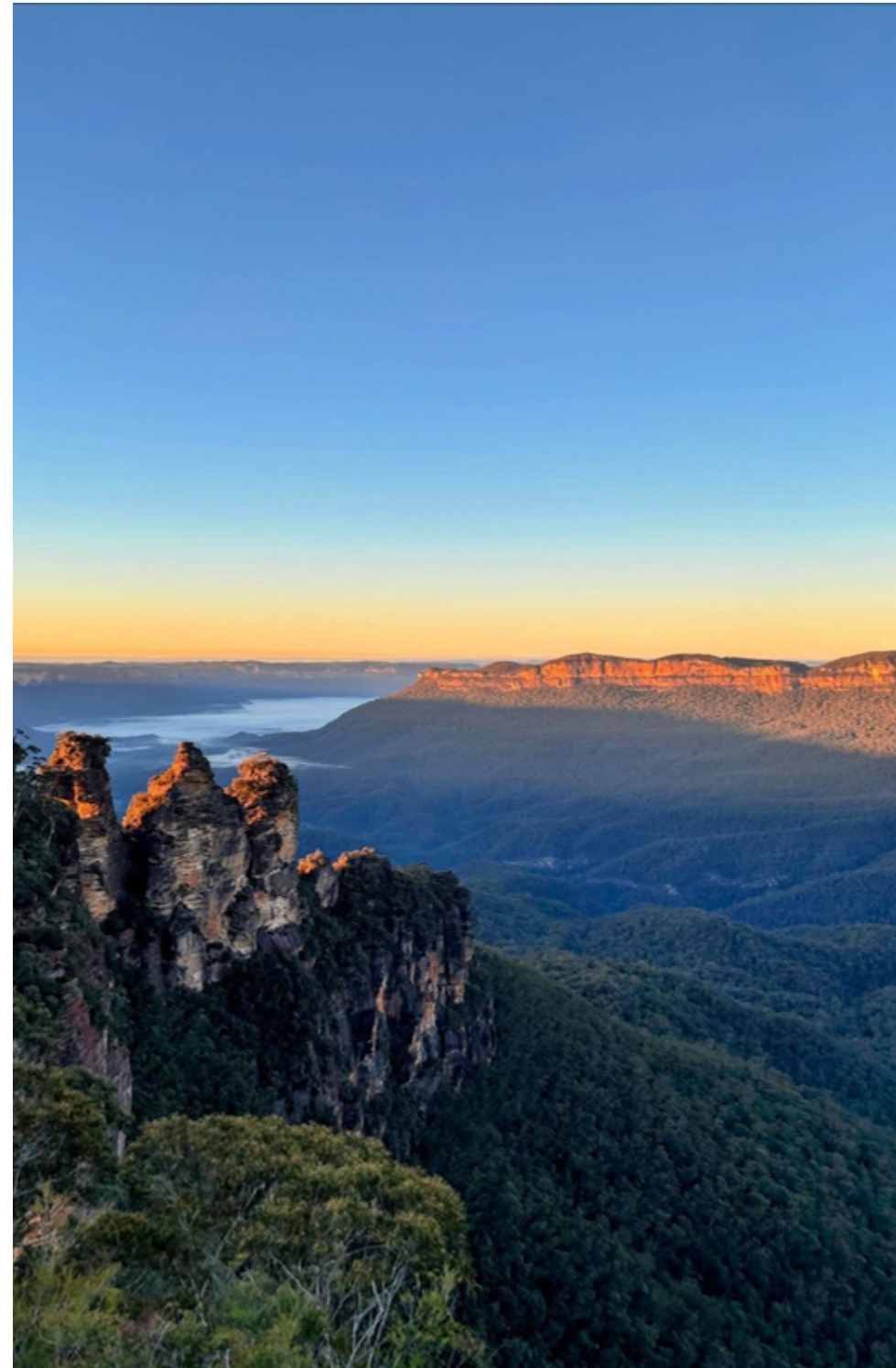


DAY ————— 03

Melbourne – MCG Ground Tour Phillip Island- Nobbies Reserve Penguin Parade.

- After breakfast, Morning Visit Melbourne cricket ground (MCG). Walk on the hallowed turf of the Melbourne Cricket Club. Explore the exclusive MCC members' facilities. Also Visit Player changing rooms Cricketers' viewing room Ron Casey Media Centre Portrait of Sir Donald Bradman and Sachin Tendulkar & Cricket Victoria Bill Lawry Centre.
- Afternoon we proceed for Nobbies Centre & Phillip Island.
- First we will visit Nobbies Centre. Overlooking the Bass Strait, the Nobbies boasts spectacular clifftop views. Explore the winding boardwalks (500m in length) and see the explosive blowhole in action. Gaze out to the Nobbies rock formations and beyond to Seal Rocks, home of Australia's largest fur seal colony. You may even spot a migrating whale in the right season.
- Later we will make our way to the Penguin Parade with your guide. Penguin Parade is the largest wild penguin protection base in the world, with more than 30,000 penguins living on Phillip Island. After sunset, watch as the world's smallest fairy penguins fight in the waves, their mouths are full of food to be brought back to the nest. See the penguins swim back to the shore and waddle in line back to their nests.

Melbourne – Fruit Picking Tour

- After breakfast proceed to visit fruit orchard in the Yarra Valley, about an hour's drive from Melbourne, known for its diverse range of over 450 fruit varieties. The orchard offers year-round fruit picking and a variety of experiences, You can Hop on a tractor tour to taste exotic fruits straight from the trees and feed friendly farm animals.
- Afternoon time free for shopping and personal activities.

Melbourne – Queens Town

Queenstown - Excursion to Milford Sound Cruise

- After breakfast proceed for full day excursion trip to Milford Sound. Drive through Beech forests and glaciaded valleys before descending the steep 1:10 gradient Homer Tunnel to the magnificent Milford Sound itself. Take a cruise on the sound out to the Tasman Sea and return with time to enjoy the stunning views and spectacular waterfalls. Watch the dolphins, seals and penguins that abound here. (You enjoy vegetarian Lunch on the cruise.)
