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## VIETNAM CLASSIC TOUR

### HANOI –SAPA - DANANG – HO CHI MINH CITY- PHU QUOC

**Duration: 13 nights / 14 Days**



#### **Day 1: Arrival Hanoi – Local sightseeing**

Arrive at Noi Bai international airport & Transfer to the hotel (normal check in time after 14.00 hrs)

After desired rest proceed to visit The Temple of Literature know as Vietnam's first university. Constructed in 1070, the gardens and well-preserved architecture offers a relaxing glimpse into Vietnam's past.

Later drive out of town to visit the serene Museum of Ethnology where you observe Vietnam's diverse culture through the Museum's unique presentation of artefacts and dress used in daily life. (Museum of Ethnology is closed on Mondays). Afternoon visit to Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (from outside) and his living Quarter, then One Pillar Pagoda, which was built by Ly Thai Tong. Visit Tran Quoc pagoda on West Lake and Quan Thanh temple.

Stay overnight at hotel in Hanoi.

**(Dinner)**

#### **Day 2: Full Day Tour to Halong Bay with Cruise**

After Breakfast depart for Tuan Chau Island, Halong City (Halong bay)

Arrive Tuan Chau Harbor, welcome aboard, and safety briefing board double decker 04-hour cruise.

Arriving Bo Hon archipelago, you will visit Surprising Cave to see a lot of stalagmites and stalactites with different shapes of sea lives, the go kayaking or bamboo boat (own cost) in Luon Cave to discovery the beautiful lagoon.

Visit Titov Island with sandy beach adjacent to the towering limestone mountain with excellent backdrop of the Bay, and climb up Titov Peak for a panoramic view of the bay like paradise.

Late Afternoon return back to harbor. Disembark from cruise and drive back to Hanoi.

Stay overnight at hotel in Hanoi.

**(Breakfast + Dinner)**

#### **DAY 03: Hanoi – Sapa**

After breakfast proceed for Sapa (300 Km – 5 Hrs). Arrive Sapa in the afternoon and check in to Hotel.

Evening free to explore Sapa Market. Overnight at Hotel.

**(Breakfast + Dinner)**

#### **DAY 04: Sapa– Fansipan Mountain–Cable Car–Tram Ride- Glass Bridge**

After breakfast, proceed for full day tour to Fansipan Mountain, The highest peak in Vietnam. Then enjoy

Jaw-dropping views of swirling clouds and forested slopes by Cable Car. Later take Tram Ride to top of Fansipan Mountain & Enjoy breathtaking views of heaven's gate. Then visit Vietnam's new Glass - Bottomed suspension bridge,

recently certified as the longest in the world. The bridge is 150 metres (492ft) above the forest below, with a width of 2.5 metres and a length of 633 metres (2,073ft) it can hold the weight of 450 people at a time.

Evening enjoy at Sapa Market. Overnight at hotel.

**(Breakfast + Dinner)**

**Day 5: Sapa - Hanoi - Flight to Phu Quoc**

*After breakfast, check - out and proceed for Hanoi.*

*Arrive Hanoi and transfer to Hanoi Airport to board your flight for Phu Quoc. Arrive At Phu Quoc Airport in the evening And Transfer to hotel. Overnight at the hotel.*

**(Breakfast + Dinner)**

**Day 06: Hon Thom Cable Car-Aquatopia Water Park**

*After breakfast proceed for newly opened cable car (Hon Thom) located at South Island, which is a genuinely breathtaking experience. Riding on the cable car, you soar over a turquoise sea and islands with an amazing view. With the length of 8 km, the Phu Quoc cable car route is the longest non-stop three-way cable car in the world recorded by the Guinness Book of World Records. Upon arrival at Island, Enter Aquatopia Water Park- Southeast Asia's largest water park with more than 20 modern games from the world's leading manufacturers, 6 themed check-in zones for the first time appearing on the mysterious deserted and wild aboriginal island, Aquatopia -The forgotten aboriginal island promises to be the most attractive destination.*

*Evening return back to the hotel. Overnight at hotel.*

**(Breakfast + Dinner)**

**Day 07: Grand World Phu Quoc**

*After Breakfast morning proceed for Grand World entertainment and shopping complex. Grand World Phu Quoc owns splendid and magnificent architecture which is inspired by the European cities. As soon as you set foot on this place, you will immediately feel impressed with a wide range of eye-catching colorful buildings. Visit Teddy Bear Museum, Inspired by the movie Indiana Jones, the museum has 5 separate zones which are divided into different floors. The place recreates and stores the artifacts that Teddy Jones owned during his journey. Coming to Teddy Bear Museum, tourists of any age, especially children, also have an opportunity to hear about the birth of the teddy bear and take photos with many cute teddy bears in different sizes. Late evening enjoy The Quintessence of Vietnam Show, With an area of up to 11,200 square meters and more than 300 veteran dancers, this show will promisingly give you a feeling of excitement with its huge scale as well as modern performance technology. The main background for the show is the bustling ancient capital with life like moving horses and carriages. Thus, it can ultimately recreate an old Vietnam with unique culture and bold national identity & then enjoy The Charm of Venice show. Overnight at hotel.*

**(Breakfast + Dinner)**

**Day 08: Full day Vinwonders Theme Park – Vinpearl Safari.**

*After Breakfast proceed for Vinpearl Safari, Explore the wild habitat of the many rare species like Bengal tigers, lions, white rhinoceros, leopards, etc. The animal feeding activity also enables you to learn more about the behavior and care of animals, 20 rare primate species such as chimpanzees, Mandrillus sphinx, and yellow-cheeked gibbons, There are more than 2000 colorful birds such as Macaw, crowned crane, red-crowned crane, scarlet ibis, grey-headed swamp hen, lesser adjutant, and innumerable other birds singing together. This is also home to wild animals from all over the world such as Arabian oryx, gaur, Malayan tapir, scimitar oryx, Bongo antelope, etc. It displays more than 20 diverse reptile species such as Aldabra giant tortoise, Indian star tortoise, chameleon, leopard gecko, and eurmese python. Afternoon, Discover Vin Wonders Theme Park, Biggest theme park in Vietnam and top in Asia with six experience areas for all guests like European Streetmosphere: includes the main gate, shopping street and the central castle, indoor hustling games village with over 50 games machine. An area of nearly 50 hectares with 6 special themes, The world's fastest roller coaster, A show comparable to the world's leading parks, attractive experiences for families, couples and groups of friends are waiting to be discovered here. Overnight at hotel. Late evening return back to the hotel.*

*Stay overnight at hotel in Hanoi.*

**(Breakfast + Dinner)**

**Day 09: Phu Quoc - Danang**

*After breakfast Morning proceed To Phu Quoc airport to board your flight for Danang.  
Arrive At Danang Airport and after customs formalities transfer to hotel. (room check in at 14.00 hrs).  
Evening Free For Rest and to explore the resort. Overnight at the hotel.*

**(Breakfast + Dinner)**

**Day 10: Danang-Full day Bana Hill tour with Sunworld Theme Park.**

*After breakfast Proceed For full day excursion tour to Bana Hills. You have a chance to ride on a modern system of cable cars helps you get a birds-eye view, very miraculous and attractive while enjoying a feeling of flying in the blue sky amidst the clouds and wind.*

*Enjoy "Golden Bridge" at Ba Na Hill. The bridge is located at a height of 1,400M, between a sea of clouds.*

*One of the best loved destinations in Ba Na Hills is the French Village, which re-enacts an old fashioned and tranquil France lined with recognizable classical landmarks such as the square, church, town, old village and inns.*

*Sun World Ba Na Hills also boast a dizzily vibrant and fascinating indoor game zone. Fantasy Park is the largest indoor game zone of Vietnam that includes countless games, recreations and sports for families. The Jurassic Park is a must-visit for children fans of the namesake blockbuster "Jurassic Park". Besides, this complex also offers the first wax museum of Vietnam, in which lifelike figurines are modeled after prominent celebrities worldwide.*

*Evening return back To Danang. Stay overnight at hotel in Danang.*

**(Breakfast + Dinner)**

**Day 11: Danang City Tour-Visit Hoi An Town- Lantern Boat Ride.**

*After breakfast we will visit Lady Buddha on Son Tra Peninsula where they have the highest Lady Buddha Statue in Vietnam (69 meters). From the entrance you will be able to see the entire young Da Nang city.*

*Later Continue to visit Cham Museum was constructed in the ancient Cham Pa architecture style with many blocks of white building decorated with simple and elegant patterns. Later we will visit Dragon Bridge – famous bridge of Danang City. The last tourist attraction is Han Market, we will discover local life, local people there, you also can buy local gift for your friends*

*Afternoon visit Marble Mountain, we will visit the Non Nuoc Village at the foot of Marble Mountains. The village is famous for stone sculptures and handicrafts. Here you can buy many things made of marble stone, from small one like earrings, necklaces, vases to the huge sculptures of Buddha. Enjoy 01 Lantern Boat Ride.*

*Later proceed to visit town of HoiAn for city tour. Here we visit 400 years old Japanese Bridge, 300 years old Chinese temple, 200 years old Vietnamese former merchants' house.*

*Stay overnight at hotel in Danang.*

**(Breakfast + Dinner)**

**Day 12: Danang - Ho Chi Minh City.**

*After Breakfast Morning depart for Danang airport to board your flight for Ho Chi Minh City (Saigon) Arrive Ho Chi Minh City & transfer to hotel.*

*Ho Chi Minh City is the largest city, business and financial hub of Vietnam. Also known as Saigon, it has a prominent history going back hundreds of years. There are plenty of museums showcasing the country's dark wartime history and classic colonial architecture built by former French rulers. This City is also Heaven for Shopping lovers with malls like Saigon center, Saigon square and Vincom mall where you can shop for famous international brands and local Vietnamese products.*

*Stay overnight at hotel in Ho Chi Minh city.*

**(Breakfast + Dinner)**

**Day 13: Full day Sightseeing in Ho Chi Minh City & Cu Chi Tunnels.**

*After breakfast morning enjoy city tour that includes the Reunification Hall, formerly known as the Presidential Palace. It was towards this modern building that Communist tanks rolled on the morning of April 30, 1975, as Saigon fell. This fascinating building is filled with history still fresh in the minds of many. The tour also includes the Old Post Office, the Notre Dame Cathedral, the Jade Emperor Pagoda, Chinatown and Binh Tay Market – the central market for the city and one of the liveliest areas.*

*Next we visit the Cu Chi Tunnels, the incredible network of tunnels that once stretched for 210 miles. This underground complex was built by guerilla fighters beginning in 1940 and construction continued throughout the Vietnam War. Late afternoon return back to hotel.*

*Evening Free for Shopping in famous malls. Stay overnight at hotel in Ho Chi Minh city.*

**(Breakfast + Dinner)**

**Day 14: Ho Chi Minh City – Drop At Airport.**

After Breakfast at hotel time free for some last-minute shopping. (room check out at 12.00 hrs)

Afternoon transfer to airport to board your flight.
