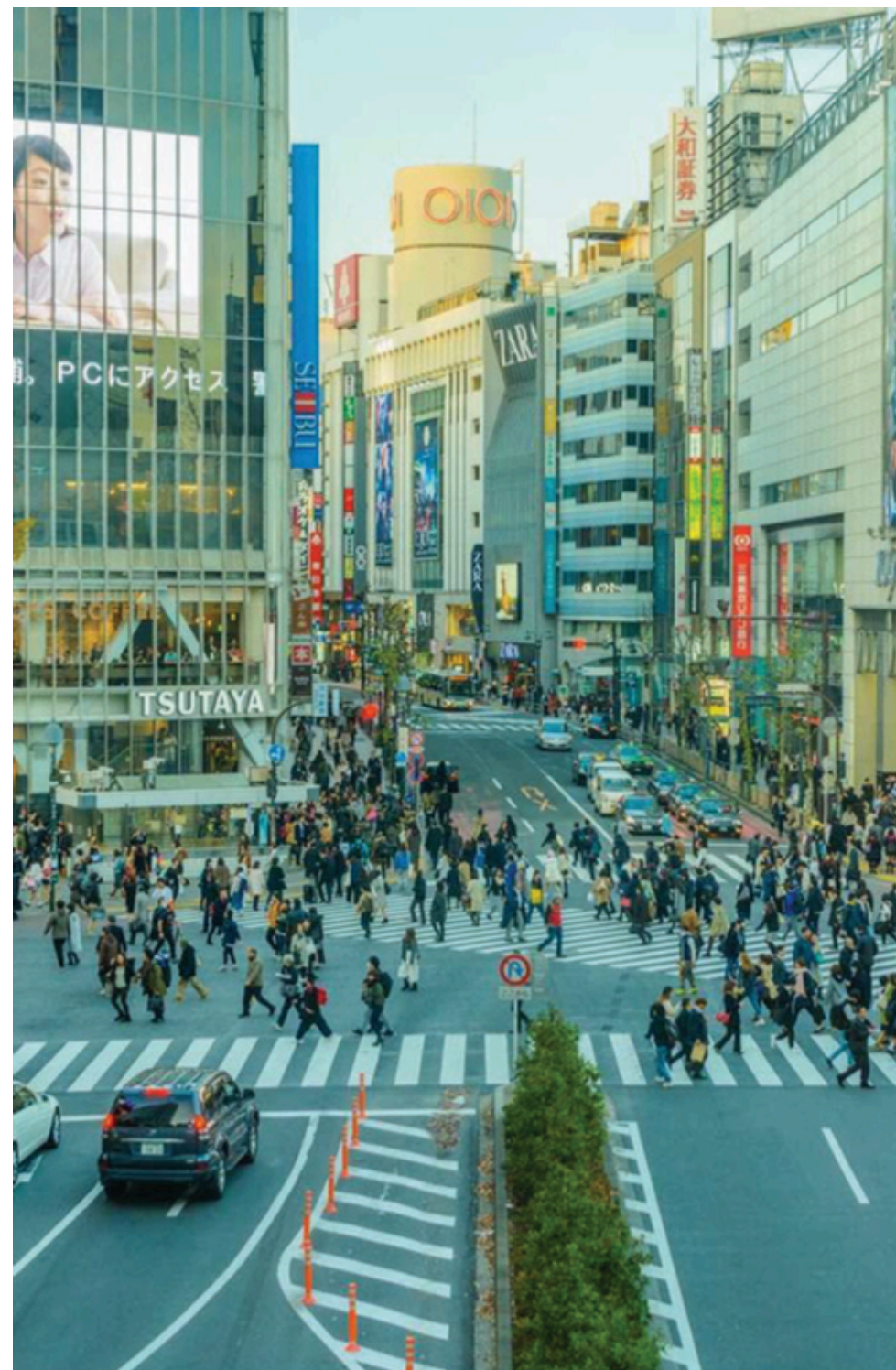

- In the evening, enjoy shopping at Shinsaibashi for fashion, cosmetics, and dining, followed by Sennichimae Doguyasuji Shopping Street, famous for street shopping and souvenirs.

- Later transfer to Hotel near Osaka Kansai Airport.

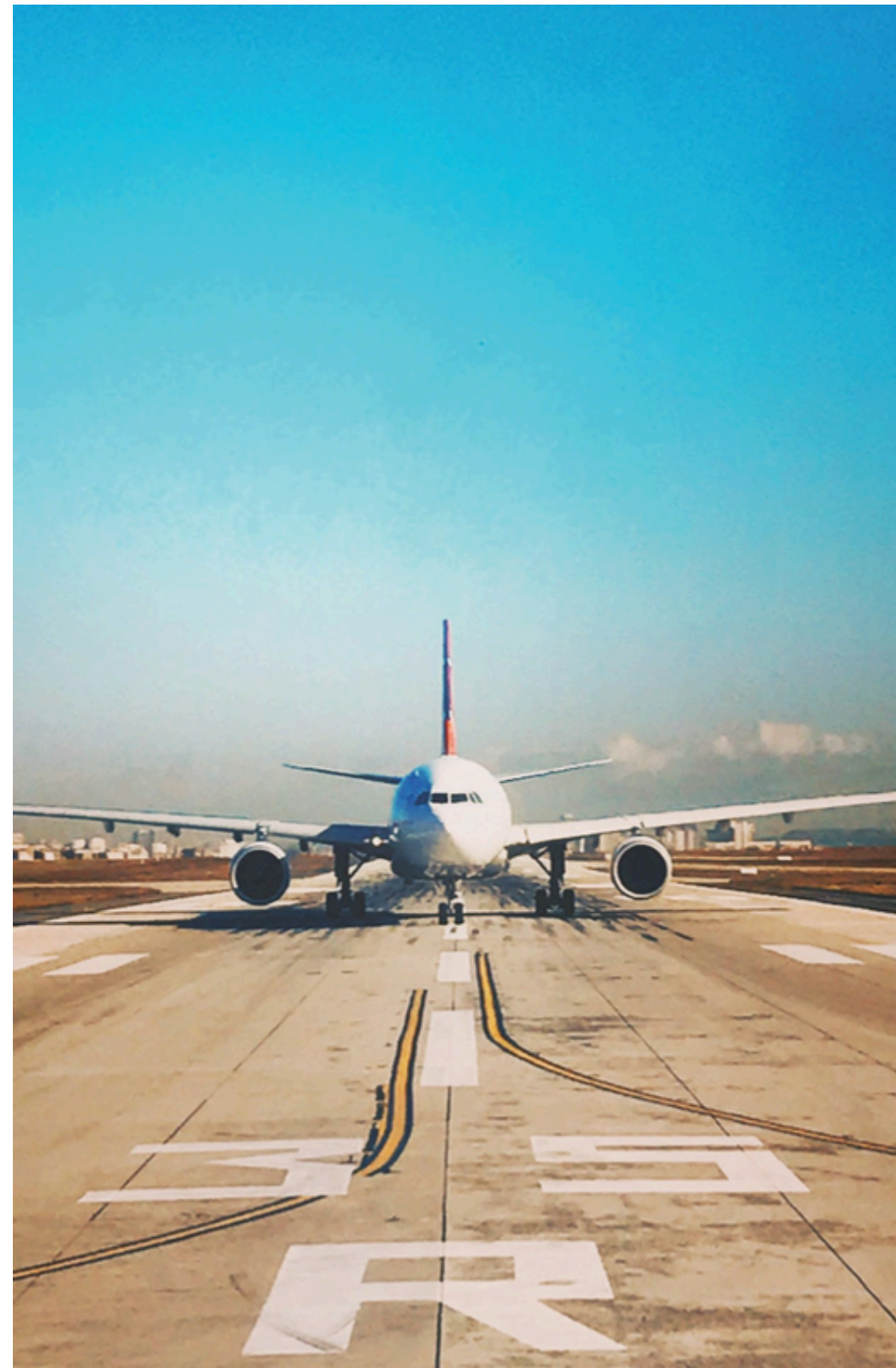
