DAY 01:- ARRIVE BARCELONA

On arrival at the Barcelona airport, meet tour manager in arrival area and proceed to your hotel & check in. Day free to explore the neighborhood.

Evening Visit To Poble Espanyol (Poble Espanyol is architecture, art, tradition, handicrafts, open air, as well as being a unique space for family-friendly activities, concerts and exhibitions in Barcelona. To sum up; Poble Espanyol is culture and leisure for young and old alike)

DAY 02:- BARCELONA

After a buffet breakfast, get a taste of the top attractions of Barcelona and see the highlights of this Catalan Capital. Proceed for tour of Passieg De Gracia, an elegant boulevard that hosts a wealth of modernist architecture like La Pedreda and Casa Batllo, before discovering La Sagrada Famillia. (Its a massive, unfinished Roman Catholic basilica in Barcelona, Spain, designed by architect Antoni Gaudí, known for its unique blend of Gothic and Art Nouveau styles, deep religious symbolism, and organic, nature-inspired forms, making it a world-famous architectural marvel and UNESCO World Heritage site)

Overnight at hotel in Barcelona.

DAY 03:- BARCELONA- EXCUSION TO MONTSERRAT & BLACK MADONNA

After a buffet breakfast, spend a day outside of Barcelona visiting the Benedictine Monastery complex of Montserrat. Enjoy views of the Catalunya countryside before heading up the mountain by cable car.

Learn about the legend of the miraculous apparition of the Black Madonna and Child in the cave of Santa Cova. Later drive through Lluis Company's Olympic stadium also known as the Barcelona Olympic Stadium with a capacity of 54,367 seats it is the sixth largest stadium in Spain (Photo stop).

DAY 04:- BARCELONA - VALENCIA

After Breakfast Depart For Valencia.

Arrive Valencia in the afternoon and transfer to the hotel and check-in.

Valencia is a place full of contrasts with charming old towns next to Futuristic buildings. It is the most welcoming cities of Spain.

Visit Oceanographic, located in the City of Arts & Sciences Complex, it features species from many of the world's key marine ecosystems. Immerse yourself in the unique marine world and travel through the longest underwater tunnel in Europe. You can meet 45000 aquatic creatures from 500 different species. Overnight stay at Valencia.

DAY 05:- VALENCIA - GRANADA

This day after breakfast, proceed for Granada

Granada is a city located in southern Spain's Andalusia region, in the foothills of the Sierra Nevada Mountains. It is one of the most charming cities of Europe. Serene Islamic architecture, monumental churches, old school tapas bars and counterculture graffiti art combine to make Granada a compelling city break.

On arrival transfer to the hotel and check-in

Later visit Alhambra – the palace and fortress complex. It is one of the most famous monuments of Islamic Architecture and one of the best-preserved palaces of the historic Islamic world, in addition to containing notable examples of Spanish Renaissance architecture.

Overnight stay at Granada.

DAY 06:- GRANADA - MALAGA

After breakfast at the hotel, proceed for Malaga.

Beyond its 16 sunny beaches, this Andalusian city on the shores of the Mediterranean has a fascinating cultural side. It is the birthplace of Pablo Picasso and is home to various museums. It is a city full of passion that is wonderful to explore.

(Enroute we will visit Nerja caves where we will stop for Picnic Lunch. If someone wants to go inside Nerja caves they can do it at own cost)

On arrival transfer to the hotel and check-in.

Overnight stay at Malaga.

DAY 07:- MALAGA - VISIT WHITE VILLAGE

After Breakfast morning free to enjoy the beach.

Afternoon proceed for day trip to white village.

Visit the beautiful white village with its stunning mountain views.

Evening return back To The Hotel.

DAY 08:- MALAGA - RONDA - SEVILLE

Admire the great arches of this ancient place. Enjoy a walk along the cities of Ronda, in the footsteps of writers such as Garcia Lorca and Ernest Hemingway. Also visit the Puente Nuevo, the newest and largest of the three bridges on the Guadalevin River)

Seville is a city that leaves its mark be it the grandeur of its Monuments or the charm of its streets. The scent of jasmine in its squares and the Spanish guitar music in the streets make it truly memorable.

On arrival, check-in to the hotel.

Evening enjoy a spellbinding live Flamenco performance at a Flamenco theatre. Be swept away by the dance, songs, instrumentals and the passion of world-class performers. Overnight stay at Seville.

DAY 09:- SEVILLE

This day after breakfast, proceed to explore the city of Seville

Visit the Royal Alcazar of Seville and marvel at the stunning medieval palace. Walk around and marvel at the stunning architecture and the beautiful gardens. Also discover the Alcazar's role as a filming location for the Game of Thrones TV Series.

Visit the Sevilla Cathedral and learn about the rich and the cross-cultural history of this holy site. Climb the Giralda, the cathedral's bell tower.

Overnight stay at Seville.

DAY 10:-SEVILLE - FARO - LISBON

Morning after breakfast, check-out from the hotel and depart for Lisbon.

En-route visit Faro.

Faro, is the capital of southern Portugal's Algarve region. There is an archaeological museum and the Bishop's Palace, a Renaissance cathedral that was heavily bombed during World war II, but later rebuilt. Nearby in Estoi are Roman Ruins and Albufeira, a fishing village influenced by the Moors in the 18th century.

Later proceed for Lisbon.

Arrive Lisbon, check-in at the hotel and relax.

Lisbon, Portugal's hilly coastal capital city, it has got everything you would want from a Centuries-old European city, with it's winding cobblestone streets and a skyline dotted with medieval castles.

Overnight stay at Lisbon.

Then head to Porto Cathedral and Ferdinandina Wall followed by Batalha Square and Vila Nova de Gaia.
